MODULE 1	INTRODUCTION This module provides the key fundamentals of project management, major concepts and philosophies, main skills and expectation of project practitioners.

MODULE 7	PROJECT COST MANAGEMENT This module presents the processes, tools and techniques used to estimate costs and to ensure that the project is completed within the approved budget.
MODULE 8	PROJECT QUALITY MANAGEMENT This module presents the processes, tools and techniques required to ensure that the project will correctly satisfy the needs for which it was undertaken.
MODULE 9	PROJECT HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT This module presents the processes, tools and techniques required to make the most effective use of the people involved with the people
MODULE 10	PROJECT COMMUNICATIONS MANAGEMENT This module presents the process, tools and techniques required to ensure timely and appropriate generation, collection, dissemination, storage and ultimate disposition of project information

MODULE 11	PROJECT RISK MANAGEMENT This module presents the systematic process of identifying, analysing and responding to project risk
MODULE 12	PROJECT PROCUREMENT MANAGEMENT This module presents the processes, tools and techniques required to acquire the goods and services to attain project scope from outside the performing organization
MODULE 13	PROJECT STAKEHOLDER MANAGEMENT This module presents the inputs, tools and techniques required to acquire to manage stakeholders on a project.
